- Has experience of working with children on the autistic spectrum.
- Understands how to move children's learning on within a lesson and understands how to support a child on a one to one basis.
- Is willing to learn new things; reflecting and developing at all times.
- Is prepared to be challenged every day but looks forward to making a difference to the lives of our fantastic young people.
