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Share a story with an adult. Can you make a sock puppet to help you tell the story?	Do a dance to music some. Can you do a slow dance? Can you do a fast dance?	Sing a nursery Rhyme. Draw a picture about the rhyme	Find objects in your house to help you count to 5, 10, 20	Make a picture out of things around your house e.g. food packets, newspaper, magazines etc
Play sleeping bunnies with an adult or sibling	Play a clapping game with an adult can you copy their beat?	Have a birthday party for one of your toys	Do head, shoulders, knees and toes. Can you add in other body parts?	Play musical statues
Paint a picture of your favourite toy	Help an adult make lunch and have a picnic - bring your teddies!	Make musical instrument using things in your house e.g. pots and pans. Can you and your family make a band.	Teach an adult 5 little monkeys	Draw a picture of your family
Play I spy	Find things in your house taller and shorter than you	Make a scrap book of your favourite things/people	Go on a listening walk around your house. What can you hear?	Make a rocket out of junk modelling
Teach an adult Humpty Dumpty. Can you decorate an egg together?	Find things in your house that start with the same sound as your name	Organise your toys by colour, size, and other features	Make a card for someone home and post it to them.	Create and decorate your own number cards to 10
Use your toys to create a puppet show	Make a den	Play Simon says	Make up a story with an adult.	Draw a picture of your friends at nursery
