(time it and record it over the week in a chart, then work out your best time)	Create a times table board game. (play it with your family)	Write a list of all electrical items in each room.
Make up a dance routine to your favourite song.	Practise your spellings from your planner. Use different methods from your planner to make it interesting.	Find a recipe. Change it. Bake it.	Create a word search using Y3/4 spellings. (Back of your planner)	Read out loud to someone using expression.
3D Spy. Look around your house. What 3D shapes can you find? Can you name them all?	Create a Roman Shield.	Draw a map of your local area - you will need this for an other activity later on! (label it)	Use your imagination and create a new invention. What is it called? What does it do?	Practise your Times tables rolling numbers.
Get building. Build a Lego tower, a tower out of playing cards or something else.	BOX ROAD Flatten a box and create your road. Add small boxes as houses.	Write a postcard to Mr Green.	Create a music video with your family.	JUNK MODEL Create a model of the Eiffel Tower.
Watch a film of your choice and write a film review	Write a story for a member of your family to read.	Pick one character from the film and create a sock puppet.	Hop scotch (pick a time table) and chant it as you go through.	Write a song/rap about your favourite subject

Write a play script about 'Charlie and the chocolate Factory'	Have Egg and spoon race with your family.	Help around the house. E.g.
