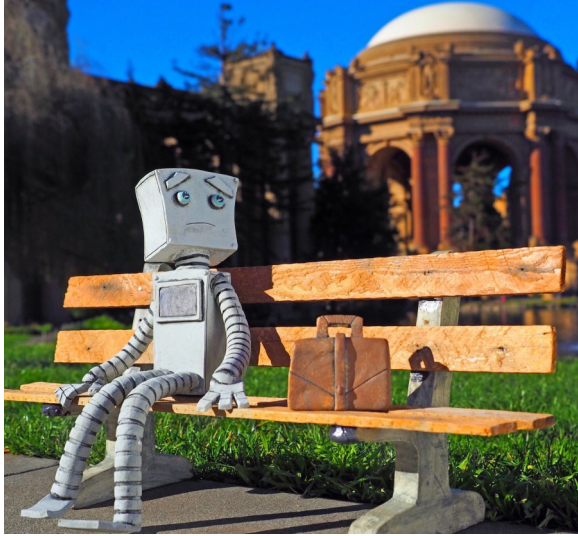


Reading

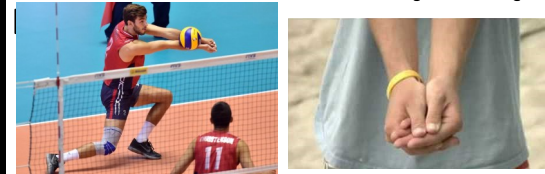
RE
