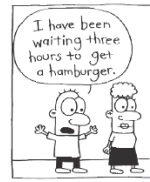
## Diary of a Wimpy Kid

44 Easily recognisable, thanks to their  
 49 horizontal and vertical layout, comic  
 55 strips include a series of hand-drawn  
 62 illustrations set out in sequence to tell  
 68 a story. Other features include speech  
 74 and thought bubbles, sound effects and  
 79 minimal narration. Over time, these  
 85 strips have evolved to become colourful,  
 91 printed comic books covering the antics  
 97 of a range of well-known characters  
 100 and action heroes.

107 Comic strip art has become a popular  
 114 craft, with the role of the cartoonist  
 120 (the artist specialising in the comic  
 127 strip style) proving to be a viable  
 129 career choice.
