

## Phonics, Spelling and Decoding

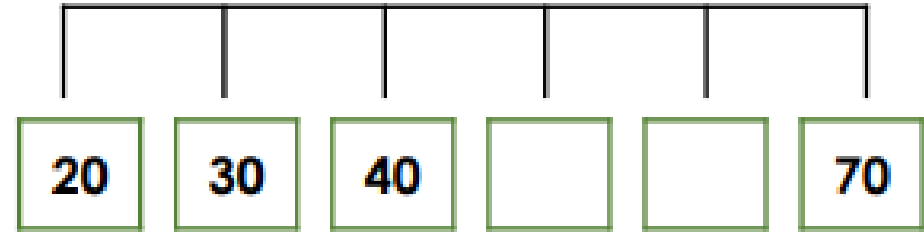
The children are taught in phonics groups not as a whole class so children will have different work for phonics depending on their group.
