MATHS	<p>Draw a map of the zoo that Hannah and the gorilla visited.</p> <p>Then calculate the approximate area of your zoo.</p> <p>Draw in animal enclosures, ponds, buildings etc and calculate the approximate area for each.</p>	<p>You are at the café with Hannah and gorilla, you have £20 to spend. Look at the menu and try to get as close to £20 as possible.</p> <p>Burger. £2.45 Sausage £1.65 Chips. £2.00 Nuggets. £3.25 Pizza. Sm £5.50 LG £7.75 Gammon £5.45 Juice. £1.00 Milkshake £2.75 Tea. £1.80</p>	<p>Hannah wrote a 500 word story over two evenings. The first evening she wrote $\frac{6}{10}$ (fraction) and on the second evening she wrote the rest.</p> <p>How many words did she write on the first evening?</p> <p>How many words did she write on the second evening? What fraction was this?</p>	<p>Using the 24 hour clock, write a schedule for the caring of the gorillas in the zoo.</p> <p>Include: feeding times, waking up, changing bedding, water etc.</p>	<p>Hannah and Gorilla were watching a film that was an hour and a half long. $\frac{5}{6}$ of the way through the film, the gorilla got hungry and went to get popcorn.</p> <p>Remember there are 60 minutes in 1 hour</p> <p>How many minutes of the film had they watched before the gorilla got hungry? How many minutes of the film did they have left to watch?</p>

How does the setting (picture) reflect Hannah's emotions?</p> <p>Draw your own picture to show how Hannah is feeling and describe what she's thinking.</p>	<p>Create a list of for and against arguments for animals being kept in zoos.</p> <p>Which side do you agree with? Write a paragraph explaining your opinion.</p>	<p>Imagine that you are one of the gorillas in the zoo. Write a description from their point of view about what they see and how they feel being caged up.</p> <p>We are all staying in a lot at the moment- how does this feel?</p>	<p>Write a poem describing the picture on page 24, Hannah and the gorilla dancing.</p> <p>Try to include a simile, alliteration, metaphor, repetition and onomatopoeia.</p>	<p>It is 6 months after Hannah's birthday, create the next two pages in the book describing how life is for Hannah now. Has it stayed the same? Does her dad have more time for her? Does the gorilla return?</p> <p>You decide what Hannah's future will be.</p>
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
