Dear Parents / Carers, As we head into December next week we thought we would outline some of the things we are doing in relation to Christmas.

Christingle: Friday 1st December

Years 1-6 will be attending a service in the church. The service will be in the morning this year. We are aiming to arrive at church with the children by about 9am so the service will start shortly after that. Last year lots of parents/ family members joined us. It is a really nice service to get you all into the Christmas spirit so hope to see you there.

Halesowen Christmas Tree Opening: Monday 4th December

This year years <u>3 and 4</u> will be joining many other schools in the local area in singing carols in the town centre. The mayor will be there doing a short speech. We will be walking the children to town and back afterwards - so children will be collected from school as normal. The singing is due to start at 2.15 and finish at 2.45. Please note, we may be a little bit late back to school (we may not). Your Annual General Consent covers this but don't hesitate to ask if you have any questions.
