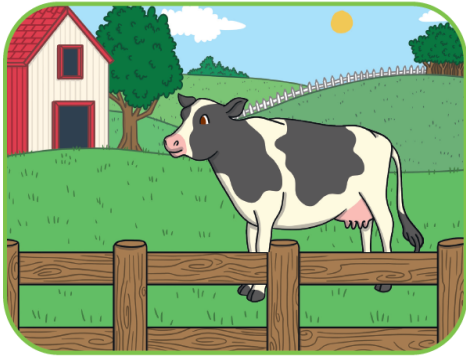


Down at the Farm

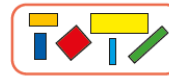

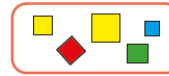
