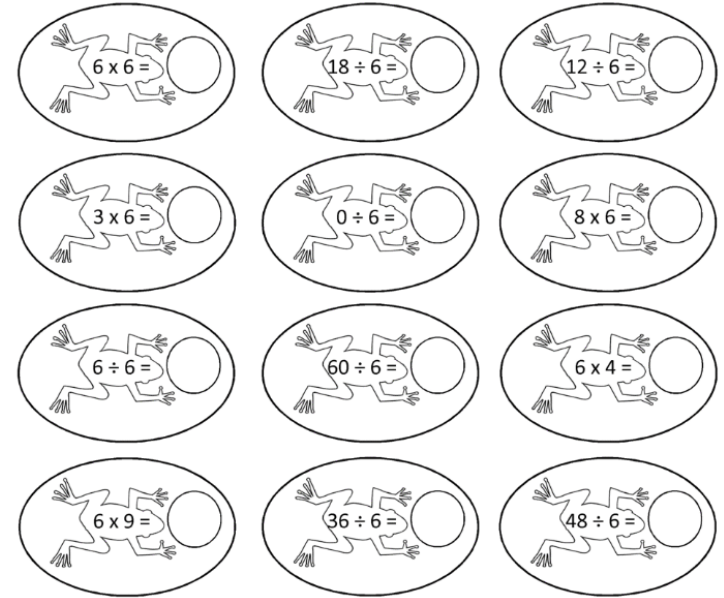

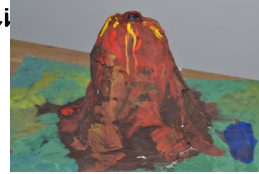
History
