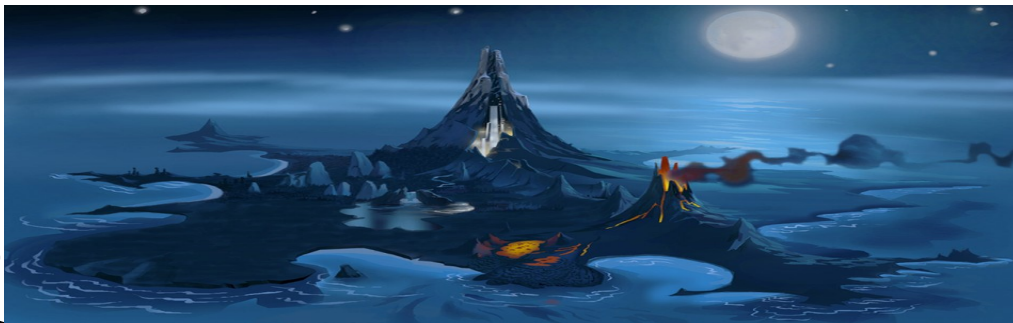

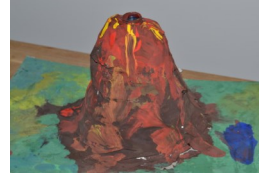
History
