










*Read the passage to a grown up. Use your phonics to help you – the find and circle all of the adjectives.*

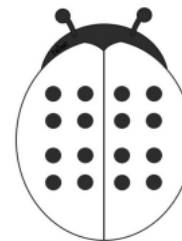
