Most of Year 1 should be able to do phase 2 and 3

Most of year 2 should be able to do Phase 4 and 5

Again children may have forgotten sounds- don't worry. If they can't do one or two try a different one

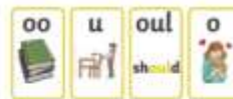
