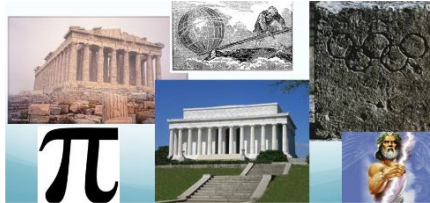
Art
