






Maths	<p>There is a clock in the picture, above the door. The numbers are written in roman numerals, an old fashioned way of writing numbers. Can you write the numbers we have on clocks today in both numbers and words.</p> <p>Challenge: Why are clocks so important? Practise telling the time each day to the hour and at half past.</p>	<p>Think about how the man entered the secret passage.</p> <p>Using the following words which are linked to sequencing time, tell someone how he got there. <i>First, next, after that, before.</i></p>	<p>Look carefully at the picture. Find a circle, square and rectangle.</p> 	<p>Count how many candles you can see in the picture.</p> <p>Practise counting in 5's. To help you create groups of 5 things. For example 5 straws together.</p> <p>See if you can find the missing number:</p> <p>0, 5, 10, __, 20, 25</p>	<p>Find all the keys you can at home. Count how many there are altogether. Then have a go at creating addition and subtraction number sentences.</p> <p>Challenge yourself by drawing the sentence so instead of numbers you have pictures of keys e.g.</p>

English	Look at the picture below and discuss the following questions. What can you see? What do you think the man in the picture is doing? How did he find the secret passage? Why is it a secret? Why is there a book at the front on fire? What might be further on inside the secret passage? Describe the setting of the picture, what do you think that place is like?	Look at the book that's on fire. Write your own short story about how that book caught fire. Does the man know the book is on fire? What might have happened? Talk to someone about this to share ideas.	Imagine you are meeting the man in the picture. What would you ask him? For example Miss Shahan would ask him How did you find the secret passage? Tell someone the questions you would ask and write them down. Don't forget to use a capital letter, finger spaces and question mark because it is a question.	Write a list of all the different things you can see in the picture. Then play I-spy with someone using the picture.	If you look closely at the picture, there is a large key near the door on the right side. Why do you think the key might be there? Find a key at home and describe what it feels and smells like. Challenge yourself by having two keys and compare them both. Do they look the same? If not, what is different about them? Do they both open the same lock?
