You can draw the item or draw around the item onto paper.</p>	<p>Create a chart Using your work from yesterday we can make a chart to show our results. Do you think this is a mini town or the same size as the buildings we have?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How tall do you think the buildings are? • How tall are the people? <p>(Can you think of this in centimetres? or metres?)</p> <p>If you can access the internet :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you find out what the tallest building in the world is? • Can you find out what the shortest building in the world is? 	<p>Still thinking about the buildings can you make your own building for Strange Town out of materials from around your house?</p> <p>You could use cereal boxes, toilet rolls etc... Or even make your 3d shapes from card.</p> <p>Think of the different shapes that you use to make your building. E.g 3d? 2d? Cylinder? Cube? Etc.....</p>

Make a list, draw them or tell an adult what they are.</p>	<p>Look at the people from Strange Town, can you make a new character?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can draw it onto paper. <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Make it out of junk modelling. <p>- Try to use words to describe how it looks, sounds, smells.</p> <p>Is it thin? Tall? Has it got a beard? Horns?</p>	<p>Look at the people in the town. Are they like us? How are they different?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If you met one of the people of Strange Town, what 5 questions would you ask them? <p>e.g What do you eat?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Would you like to live in Strange Town?• If you could make a town to live in what would it look like? What would the people look like?-• Have a go at drawing a town where you would love to live. <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Describe your town to an adult.	<p>Looking at the picture a lot of the people are in silhouette (solid shape in black). Can you make your own shadow puppet of a character from Strange Town? Watch the video to help. You can use any type of card to make it- even a cereal box!</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OsdMqNlcrIs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you act out a scene with your puppets?• What would they say? How would they talk? <p>You could video this</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Record the speech onto paper as a script.</p>	<p>Can you write a letter about yourself to one of the characters in Strange Town? You could tell them all about yourself- what you like to do? What you like to eat? What your favourite school subject is ? Etc...</p> <p>You could include a picture too.</p> <p>Remember to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check your sentences make sense.• Use capital letters and full stops.• Check spellings.



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
