Can you create a newspaper report from the perspective of a Celt farmer facing the Roman Invasion?



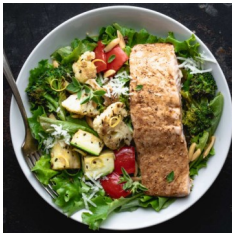
Science

Design a healthy meal for you and your family— you could also include a receipt and ingredients list with your picture.



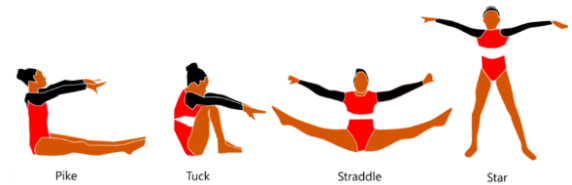
