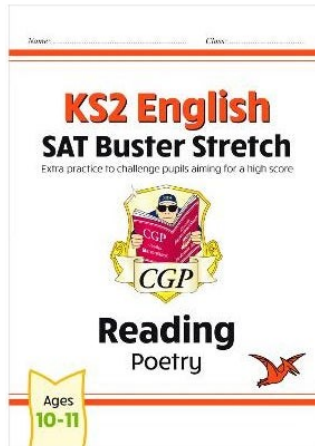


## Reading - Poetry

Read pages 23, 24 and 25 called 'Inside the World of Jam' and then answer the questions on pages 26 and 27.



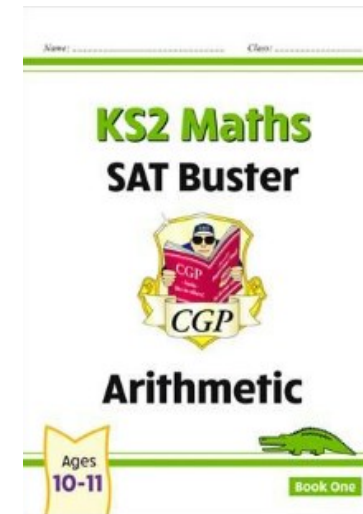

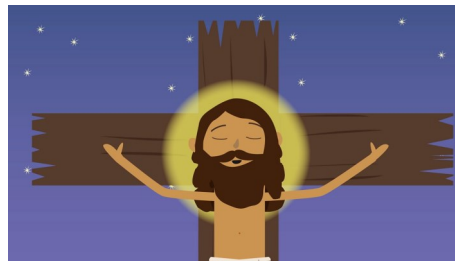
