Create a poster showing off the Olympic Games. All of your events must be in French!



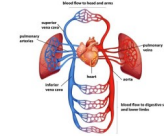
History

Choose an animal of your choice and research about its circulatory system. Is it the same as a human's circulatory system? Create a leaflet to show how each part of the animal's circulatory system works.



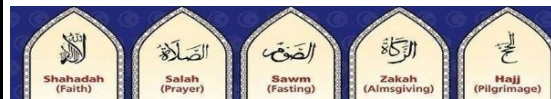
DT
