Next week we will find out who our new house captains are, we begin our first House event and will have our first Star of the Week celebration assembly. The start of a new school year is always very busy but very exciting.



Attendance

From September there is new framework to ensure consistency across schools regarding unauthorised attendance and fines. Schools are not permitted to authorise any holidays in term time. Fines have increased and also go up each time a holiday is taken, even this is in different school years. We will send out more detailed information to you soon but please try to avoid booking holidays in term time. These fines are also for a culmination of any unauthorised absences. Please make sure children are only absent from school when they are too poorly to attend and that on each occasion they are absent you call the school office.
