<p>Watch the story of Noah's Ark by clicking on the link above. Throughout the story Noah felt lots of different emotions. Can you find a time in the story when Noah was worried? Happy? Why did Noah feel this way?</p> <p>What does your face look like when you feel different emotions? Use a mirror to see how your expression changes when you feel happy, angry, sad, excited, scared.</p> <p><u>Reflection:</u> How are you feeling at the moment? Why do you feel this way? Can you think of people or things that make you happy when you feel sad?</p> <p>Links to other areas of Learning: PSED/Lit/PD: Imagine you are like Noah and have to go on the ark. There is only space for people who are special to you, people who make you happy. Can you</p>	<p>Watch the story of Noah's Ark again. Why did God choose Noah to build the ark? Noah was chosen to build the Ark because God recognised that he was a good person. Miss Minogue and Miss Ding are always impressed with how good you are at school. Can you think of some things that you do at home to show that you are making good choices?</p> <p>We would have chosen you to help build the Ark because we think you are special. Think about why God might have chosen you to go on the Ark? Do you have a special talent? What makes you special/different?</p> <p>Links to other areas of Learning: UOW: All of the animals were chosen to go on the Ark as they were all special in different ways. Watch the different animals at the zoo. What differences can you</p>	<p>Noah and his family had to be very patient on the ark waiting for the flood to stop. What does it mean to be patient? We have to be patient when we are waiting for something. Can you think of a time when you had to be patient? Here are some examples waiting for your dinner to cook, waiting for your turn on the swing, waiting for your birthday. At the moment we all have to be very patient and wait to see our friends and family and to go back to school. Is it hard sometime to be patient? How can we make it easier?</p> <p>Links to other areas of Learning: PSED: Noah has been on the boat for a long time and can't get off because of the flood. Can you think of some things he and his family could do together to stop them getting bored? Can you play a game with your family? Remember to take it in turns.</p>	<p>In the Story of Noah's Ark the rainbow was a sign of hope that appeared when the rain stopped. At the moment there are lots of rainbows in people's windows as a sign of hope and to say thank you to people who are helping us. On your daily walk can you spot any rainbows? Can you count how many rainbows you find?</p> <p>Reflection- Who helps you and looks after you? Who would you want to say thank you to?</p> <p>Links to other areas of Learning: EAD: Can you create your own rainbow as a sign of hope by mixing colours together to make the different colours of the rainbow. Use paint to see if you make the colour orange? Green? Purple?</p> <p><u>If you don't have any paint:</u> There are 7 colours in the rainbow. Red, orange, yellow,</p>	<p>God wanted Noah and all of the animals to be safe on the Ark. At the moment we all have to stay at home so that we can stay safe. During your daily walk can you use your good looking eyes to explore the area you live? What is special about the natural world around us? The</p>

What do they do to make you happy?</p> <p>Maths: Noah had to think about who was allowed on the Ark. He wanted pairs of animals for his ark. A pair means two of something. Lots of things come in pairs. What pairs can you find around your house?</p> <p>How many pairs of these can you find:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Socks• Shoes• Gloves <p>If you have playing cards at home why not play a game of snap or pairs memory game to find the matching pairs. You could always make your own pairs game by drawing some of the animals from the Ark on different pieces of paper.</p>	<p>spot between the animals? Can you move like the different animals on the ark?</p> <p>Jump like a frog Waddle like a penguin Stomp like an elephant March like an ant Slither like a snake</p> <p>What other animals can you pretend to be?</p> <p>Can you turn this into a race? Who is the fastest in your house?</p>	<p>Literacy/Physical Development:</p> <p>Another game Noah could have played on the Ark was eye spy. Look at the picture of Noah's ark. Can you find an animal on the ark beginning with these different letter sounds:</p> <p>Cc Tt Pp Mm Oo Dd Ff Bb</p> <p>Can you make a list of the animals you have found? Nursery you could try drawing the animals and if you feel confident try copying the initial sound.</p>	<p>green, blue, indigo, violet. Can you find a different object in your house for each colour of the rainbow?</p> <p>EAD: Can you make a rain maker instrument using an old cardboard tube, rice and tin foil? Which one sounds the most like rain?</p>	<p>natural world looks after us in many ways: trees give us air to breathe, flowers create a beautiful scent for us to smell, bees create honey for us to eat. How can we help look after the natural world? E.g don't drop litter.</p> <p>UOW/PSED/EAD: All of the animals would of needed to be kept safe on the Ark. Do you have a pet at home? How do you keep them safe and happy? How would you look after the animals? Can you pretend to be a vet and look after your cuddly toys?</p> <p>EAD: The Ark kept Noah and the animals safe. Can you pretend to be Noah and build a model of the Ark? You could use lego, blocks, junk modelling. You could always make a model of your safe place.</p>
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
