2. Find one word that describes the car.

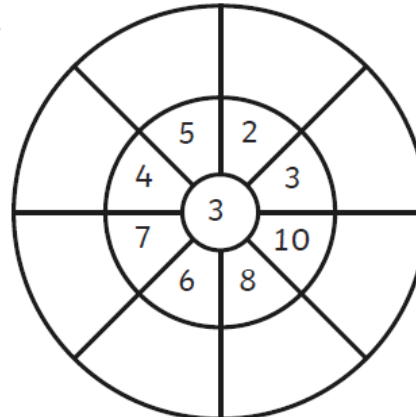
3. Why do you think Meg and Dad put lights on the spaceship?

4. What do you think will happen next?

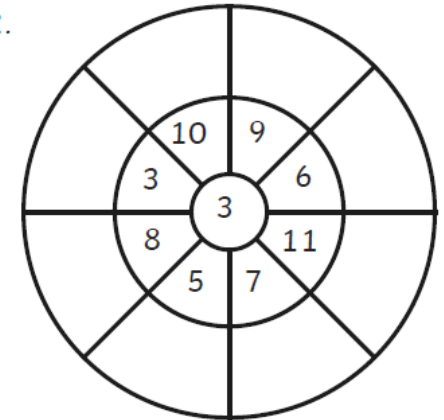
