Reading - Inference

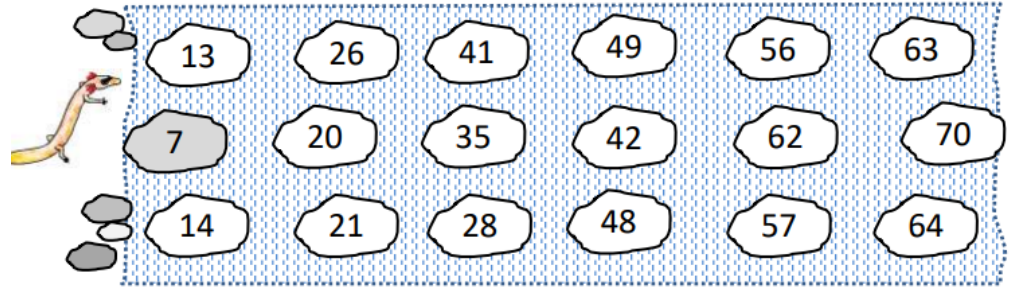

Help Captain Salamander to cross the river by shading the stepping stones counting up in 7s.



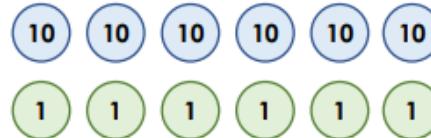

Use the counters on each question to decide if the answer is true or false. If it is false, write the correct answer.

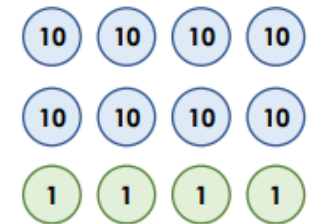
True or false? The answer is 15.

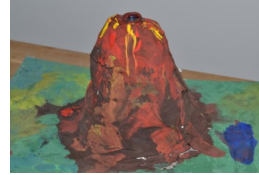
History
