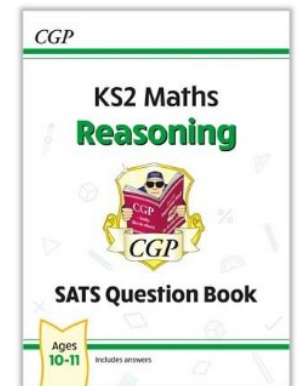

Bags are used for all sorts of things. Design 2 different bags and say what they would be used for.



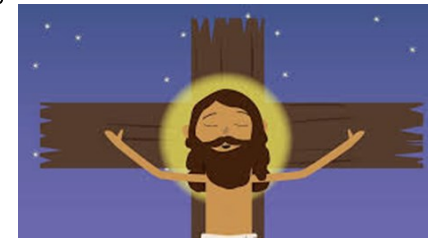
Geography
