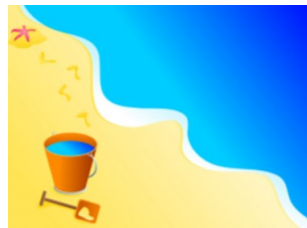


Phonics, Spelling and Decoding

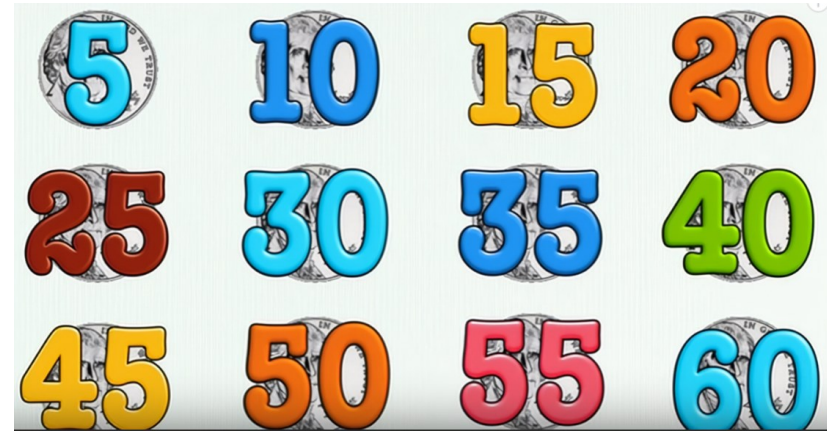
Can you read each sound and match it to the picture?

How do you think the owls are related?

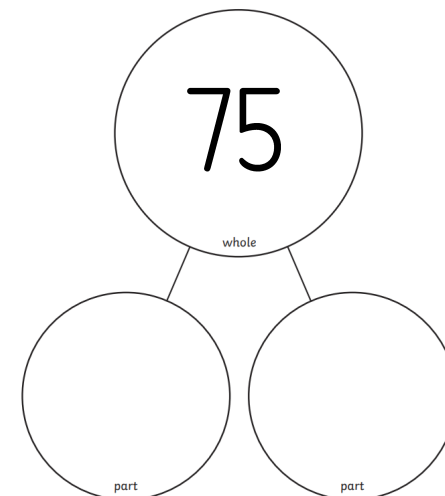
How do you think the little owl is feeling?
