Today your challenge is to go on a walk outside and find a stick. If you can not go outside then see if you can make one at home perhaps using foil or a straw. Next, use your stick to make it into a person. Using the fantastics below, use your senses and feelings to describe your stick man.</p> <p> What does it feel like?</p> <p> How does it look?</p> <p> Does it smell?</p> <p> What would your Stick man say?</p>	<p>In the story Stick Man becomes many things including a mast for a flag, a pen, a bat and a hook for a bag.</p> <p>Using your Stickman you made yesterday, think of all the things you could pretend your stick man is. Think about how it makes you feel to help you decide.
