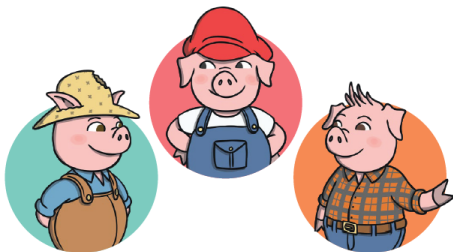


Reading

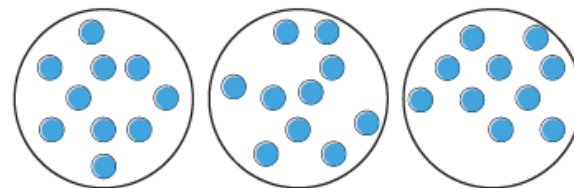

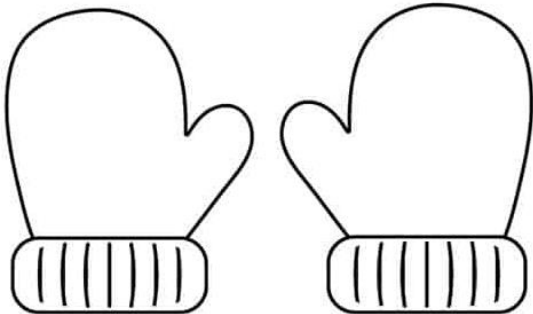
