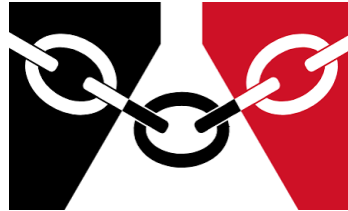
Computing
