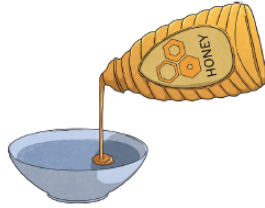

Honey Biscuits

Ingredients:

- 6 ounces self-raising flour
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 1 ounce sugar
- 2 ½ ounces margarine
- 1 level teaspoon cinnamon



Method:

1. Beat the sugar, honey and margarine until it becomes a soft, creamy consistency.
2. Sieve the flour and cinnamon. Then, add it to the mixture.
3. Mix with a wooden spoon to bind the mixture together. Next, knead with your fingers until the dough becomes soft. 
4. Roll the mixture between floured palms into 16 balls.
5. Place the dough on a lightly greased baking tray, flattening the rolls slightly.
6. Bake at 180°C for about 15 minutes until golden brown.
