Here are some ideas our staff have come up for Argentina.

- Colourful house collage- La Boca is a neighbourhood in Buenos Aries is known for its it's bright and colourful houses.

- Find the animals of Argentina and create a wordsearch.(Armadillos, Capybaras, King Penguins, Rattle Snake, Pit Viper)
- "The Cave of Hands" is a famous landmark with art work from around 13,000 years ago. Try making a piece of art work involving your hands- hand prints, draw around your hand and decorate, draw around your hand and practice cutting it out carefully.
- Argentina is a popular place for tourists to go on holiday. Buenos Aires is the Capital City and full of cafes and restaurants. Make up your own menu for one of the cafes or restaurants. What could you call the café or restaurant? Could you create your own signature dish and make it with a family member?
- Role-play being in a café/restaurant in Argentina. You could be the waiter/waitress.
- Make Empanadas (baked stuffed pastry with cheese, minced meat or sweet potato paste)
- The most popular sports in Argentina are football, basketball, rugby and tennis. If you have any of these balls, could you practise some of the key skills needed for these activities? Challenge yourself and a family member to see how many times you can practise doing a kick up or catching a ball.
- Create a new Argentina football shirt. Cut up into jigsaw pieces.
- Diego Maradona is a famous football player from Argentina. He was given the nickname 'El Pibe de Oro' What does this mean in English? He was born on 30th October 1960, How old is he today?
