## Brazil.

Here are some ideas our staff have come up for Brazil.

- Paper plate carnival masks to use with music to dance to.
- Listen to Brazilian music and create a dance
- Make a travel brochure highlighting places to see, eat, do etc.
- Compare Brazilian food to British food.
- Learn Portuguese
- Sketch the statue "Christ the Redeemer" and Mount Corcovado
- Decorate a mardi-gras mask (can find templates on twinkl)
- Learn about Brazilian festivals.
- Write a post card to your friends.
- Using musical instruments; create a piece of music that would be suitable for the carnival.
- Make a poster advertising a carnival.
- Ball skills: linked to Brazil being good at football. Dribbling, passing (at a distance), kicking etc.
- Make a carnival mask or headdress? (from paper plates and collage)
- Animals from the rainforest- research what animals live there
- Write an animal fact file. This could be linked to /amazon rainforest.
- Rainforest colouring pages.
- Rainforest animals sorting sheet (find on twinkl)
- Reading comprehensions differentiated found on twinkle.
- Make a jungle scene.
- Look at Rousseau jungle pictures (animals or people are normally hidden within the picture) can they hide animals in their drawings for others to spot?
- Animals from rainforest- paper chain snake? How long is it? Who can make the longest in a given amount of time? Can they measure it with non-standard units?
- Animals from the rainforest- origami jumping frogs?
