Egypt.

Here are some ideas our staff have come up for Egypt.

- Hieroglyphics
- Design Egyptian jewelry
- Mummify an orange or tomato and write instructions/draw a diagram to explain it
- Make papyrus paper tea stained paper. Can then draw on this Egyptian mummies/animals/ hieroglyphics etc.
- Create a poster about Cleopatra
- Write a diary entry for a pyramid worker
- Create your own Egyptian God
- Look at the Egyptian number system and try writing the numbers
- Make an Egyptian mask
- Make a canonic jar out of Pringles tube.
- Canopic jars (preserving experiment) put a slice of apple in 4 cups. Cover with different preservatives
 e.g. salt, vinegar, sugar, baking soda, control (nothing). Watch progress over the week- how does the
 apple change? Which preserves the best?
- Make a cat mummy
- Design own hierogylphics
- Write name in hieroglyphics
- Make your own book mark/name card using hieroglyphics
- Make your own Egyptian dance.
- Use a pyramid net to create a pyramid, extend this to different sizes
- Build a pyramid: look at the shape of a pyramid. Make with different objects- straws, junk modelling, bricks...
- Musical instruments make a piece of Egyptian music.
- Create a Paper mache mummy



- Make or paint a pharaoh mask (think there are some blank masks under sink cupboards in my room that could be used- not sure how many there are?)
- Hieroglyphics- print out a range of hieroglyphics can they make their own name? could they decode CVC words you have made with hieroglyphics?
