Maths

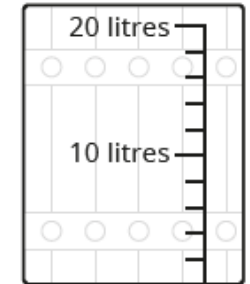
Can you solve this question— think carefully about which of the four operations you need to use! (+, -, ÷, ×)
