Many of the Roman gods were based on the Greek gods. The Romans were very impressed by the Greeks and took lots of their ideas and made them their own. The main Roman god was Jupiter. He was a sky god who ruled over everything. This was very similar to the Greek god Zeus.

Juno was also an important god. She was Jupiter's sister and also his wife! She was similar to the Greek god Hera. They believed that Juno watched over and protected women.
