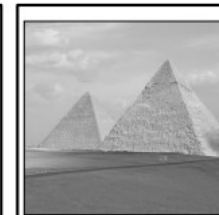

Pick a challenge to complete this week.

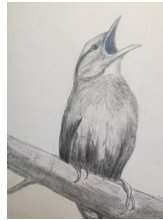
**Geography**

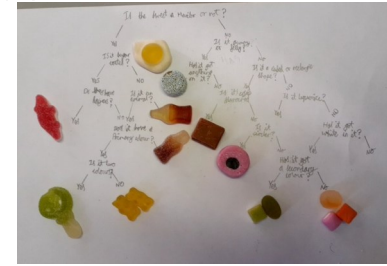
**Art**

Make some observational drawings of nature. Remember to add different textures to your drawings e.g line work, cross hatching and include shading where needed.



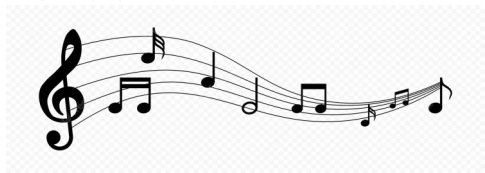
**Science**
